Booking GP Appointments On-Line

Did you know that you can sign up to book appointments on-line now? Since 1st December, patients have been able to book an appointment with a doctor on-line.

Please ask at reception for further details.



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Electronic Ordering of Repeat Prescriptions

Did you know that you can also sign up to order a repeat prescription on-line? This new service started on 1st December and is part of a pilot scheme, so we are one of the first 'Vision' (our computerised patient record system) practices to offer on-line ordering of repeat prescriptions. Please ask for an application form at reception. This new service will eventually replace the service provided via the telephone prescription line – which will cease altogether. We will give patients at least three months notice before the telephone service ends.



Health Promotion

Good progress is being made on the health promotion room and we hope to be able to open it early in the New Year.

The room will contain lots of helpful information on a variety of health conditions, including how to improve the management of your own health.

You will also be able to check your own blood pressure and hand the results to reception for recording in your own clinical record.
